

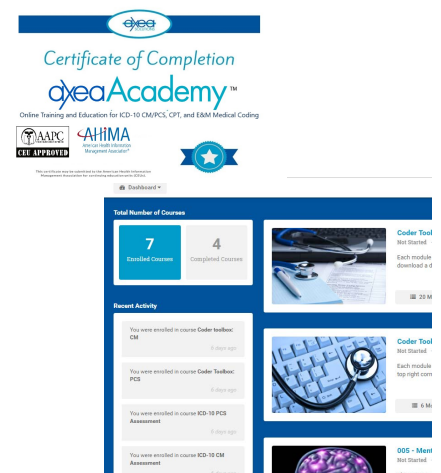

ICD-10 CM

Course 001: Infectious Diseases

Code sets for infectious and parasitic diseases, guidelines for certain infectious conditions, and detailed content for manifestation and combination coding

Course 002: Neoplasms

Code sets for neoplasms, guidelines for neoplasm code assignment, and detailed content for the different types of neoplasms

Course 003: Blood

Code sets for blood and blood forming organs, and detailed content and code specification for anemia and other blood conditions

Course 004: Endocrine Diseases

Code sets for endocrine, nutritional, and metabolic diseases, guidelines for diabetes and its impact on diagnosis code selection, and detailed content for nutritional and metabolic disorders

Course 005: Mental Disorders

Code sets for mental, behavioral, and neurodevelopmental disorders, guidelines for pain and substance use, and detailed content and code specification for mental, behavioral and neurodevelopmental disorders

Course 006: Nervous System

Nervous system code sets, guidelines for hemiplegia and hemiparesis and detailed content for conditions and diseases of the nervous system

Course 007: Eye and Adnexa

Code sets for diseases of the eye and adnexa, guidelines for glaucoma and detailed content for specific diseases of the eye

ICD-10 PCS

Courses 024, 025 and 026 provide clinical and mechanical information on common inpatient procedures. All 31 root operations are defined in detail with surgical examples and exercises within the three courses.

Course 022: Introductory Course on ICD-10 and the PCS Structure

Introductory course that outlines the history of ICD-10-PCS, the PCS structure, table organization, key attributes, characteristics, and definitions.

Course 023: Medical and Surgical Coding Guidelines

Covers detailed medical and surgical coding guidelines specific to body system, body parts and approach. The body parts section addresses the following: branches, bilateral values, coronary arteries, joint structures, tissue overlying a joint, fingers and toes, and gastroin-testinal; including the definitions and coding guidelines for approach. Components of the approach section addresses: access location, method and type of instrumentation.

Course 027: Medical and Surgical Procedures

Covers information specific to the medical and surgical procedures related to nine additional sections of ICD-10-PCS and the six ancillary sections. This includes general information, body system, root operation, code components (body part, approach, device, qualifier), and coding tips.

Course 028: CM and PCS Concepts - Basic ICD-10

Applies practical ICD-10 coding experience by utilizing concepts learned in CM and PCS courses to operative notes.

CPT

Course 029: Introduction to CPT

An overview of current procedural terminology coding, which includes an outline and clear definition of current procedural terminology, and clarification of how the CPT manual should be used in order to ensure the quality and accuracy of coding.

A review of third-party reimbursement, Medicare's outpatient prospective payment system, and correct coding initiatives. This course also provides detail on reimbursement for outpatient services, illustrating how correct coding initiatives impact coding.
